The Kihei Trail has been built and maintained by volunteers since 2002 and is a small part of the entire South Maui Coastal Heritage Corridor extending from Makena to Kealia Pond. There are benches and interpretive signs along the way and you can enjoy beautiful vistas; watch for whales, turtles, or native seabirds; and visit beaches and shops by continuing to walk further north and south. As you come to resort properties, please be respectful and walk along the property perimeters. Currently, many native

plants have been reintroduced to the area and invasive plants are being removed. The volunteers are also exploring the possibility for more handicap accessibility.
